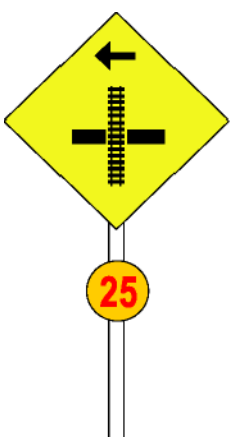

CONDITIONAL LEVEL CROSSING SPEED SIGNS

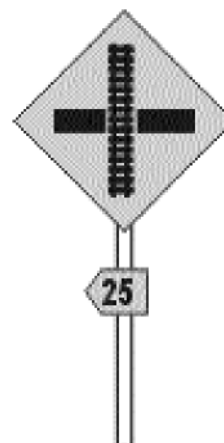
Conditional level crossing speed signs are placed on the approach to level crossings where visibility could be impaired when an adjacent line before the level crossing is occupied by rail traffic. If an adjacent line ahead of this sign, as indicated by the direction of the arrow, is occupied by rail traffic, drivers of approaching trains must reduce the speed of their train to the indicated speed. Drivers may resume the track speed indicated by the previous permanent track speed sign when the leading motive power unit has passed the level crossing.

LEVEL CROSSING SPEED SIGNS

Level crossing speed signs are placed on the approach to level crossings at locations where visibility of the level crossing is reduced. Drivers of approaching trains must reduce the speed of their train to the indicated speed. Drivers may resume the track speed indicated by the previous permanent track speed sign when the leading motive power unit has passed the level crossing.
