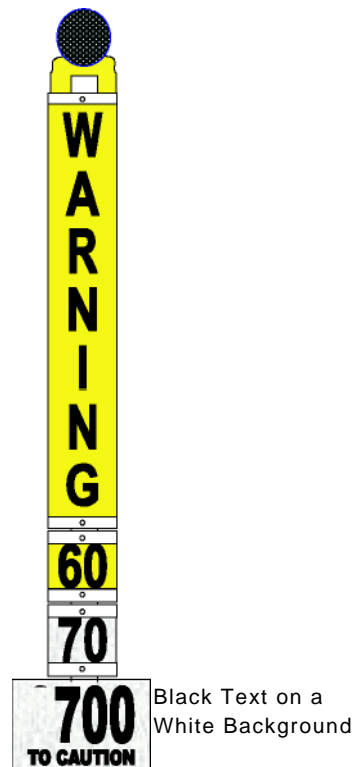
THIS SAFE NOTICE CONTAINS THE INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED IN SAFE NOTICE 007 - 2004.

### TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTIONS - TRIAL OF INTERMEDIATE "WARNING" SIGNS

From Thursday 1 July until Wednesday 31 December 2004, new Intermediate Warning Signs will be used when a train enters on to a line which is subject to a speed restriction and the train does not pass the "Warning" Sign, e.g when a train departs a maintenance centre.

#### DESCRIPTION

The intermediate warning sign will be a standard type warning sign fitted with a plate showing the distance in metres to the Caution sign as shown in the following diagram.



#### SIGN PLACEMENT:

The sign must be placed in a position where it can be clearly seen by the driver of the approaching train to ensure that the driver is aware of the Caution sign ahead..
