General Details / Operating Condition:

Commencing at 0600hrs on Saturday the 9th March 2024 continuously to 1800hrs on 11th March 2024 to allow infrastructure works to be undertaken at various times at or over the ARTC NSW and ARTC Victoria interface boundary at Albury, ARTC will apply back-to-back work on track authorities.

A NSW Local Possession Authority (LPA) will be in place from Junee Signals JE03, JE02 and JE15 to Albury Signal AY15 as per ARTC TAA 0141-2024.

A Victorian (TA20) Absolute Occupation will be in place from Tottenham Junction Signal TOT8 to Albury Signal AY15 as per ARTC TAA 0143-2024

To facilitate works at or over the ARTC NSW and ARTC Victorian interface boundary, it will not be possible to place possession protection as described within ANWT 302 Local Possession Authority (LPA), ANPR 700 Using a Local Possession Authority and TA20 Section 15 Rule 9.

Safeworking Arrangements:

Additional Details:

Whilst work is being undertaken at or over the interface boundary the following exceptions to NSW Rules and Procedures ANWT 302 and ANPR 700 and Victorian TA20 Section 15 Rule 9 will apply.

- While a worksite is required to span the ARTC NSW and ARTC Victoria interface boundary, it will not be possible to place the possession protection.
- The Possession Protection Officer (PPO) for the Local Possession Authority and the Track Force
 Protection Coordinator (TFPC) for the Absolute Occupation must confer and come to a clear
 understanding of the worksite protection to be established over the ARTC NSW and ARTC
 Victoria interface boundary.

Recipients must ensure this Notice is circulated to and understood by all personnel affected by, or needing to know, its content. This Notice must be issued to all affected Competent Workers.

Competent Workers who receive this Notice must follow the requirements.
