General Details / Operating Condition:

Commencing at 0630hrs on Wednesday 03rd April 2024 and continuing until 0630hrs on Saturday the 6th of April 2024 or until completed, the following works will occur at Togar:

- upgrade of existing 51 and 52 M3A point machines to M23A point machine,
- removal of existing 51 and 52 Traffic Huts together with associated Maintenance Call Horn facilities, wayside phones and ESML mechanisms
- installing new 51 and 52 EOL on post mounted cabinets near 51 and 52 Points Location hut where redundant Traffic Huts used to be located.

The commissioning of upgraded signalling works will involve route setting activities, signal and points testing.

Details of new equipment:

New M23A MKII points machines at 306.061km (51 points) and 307.524km (52 points) will be commissioned and booked into use.
