# General Details / Operating Condition:

Commencing at 0630 hours on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> November 2024 until 1830 hours on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2024, or until the works are completed, the following infrastructure upgrading works will be undertaken at Morandoo, Port Waratah:

- Book out of use and permanently remove the existing Nippon Point Machine from number 136 points, and
- Install, commission and book into use the new Siemens M23A MKII Point Machine and associated equipment for number 136 points.
- Book out of use and permanently remove the existing Nippon Point Machines from number 137E and 137W points, and
- Install, commission and book into use the new Siemens M23A MKII Point Machines and associated equipment for number 137E and 137W points.

The commissioning of these new arrangements will involve route-setting activities, signal testing and point testing.

### **IMPORTANT REMINDER**

After the upgrade to 136, 137E and 137W points, each will NO longer be trailable.

## **MANUAL OPERATION**

Manual operation of M23A Points Machines differs to that of the Nippon Point Machines.

The M23A points have:

- A short selector lever with MOTOR and HAND positions, and
- A long hand throw lever with NORMAL and REVERSE positions.

For manual operation of M23A points, first move the short selector lever to the HAND position, and then the long hand throw lever can be used to manually move between either the NORMAL or REVERSE position.
